State Cup Roster Instructions

A reminder that the League Roster and the State Cup roster DO NOT need to mirror each other any longer, but there does need to be a nine-player continuity. A State Cup team may also now be able to roster a recreational player from their club on the State Cup roster.

If the team is rostering a recreational player, you will roster them just as you do a travel player PLUS you will need to see a Proof of Recreational Registration from the club.

When approving a State Cup roster you will now need to approve the league roster first, if making changes to the league roster and then the State Cup roster. If no league roster changes, then you will just approve the State Cup roster.

In the State Cup roster screen, the ONLY box you will see approvals in is the "TEAM APPROVAL STATUS". The Club & League will have an N/A in them.

On the rosters there is a line for player's to sign, they do NOT need to sign the roster before you approve them. This will be done at the semi-finals and finals and the State Cup Committee will handle that with those teams.

A team that already has their league roster approved, only needs to bring to you:

2 or 3 copies of their State Cup Roster (depending on what your league requires)  
2 audit reports
